The watercolor workshop will be held at the Carrie Lane Chapman Catt Girlhood Home at 2379 Timber Avenue, Charles City, on Saturday, Sunday, and Monday from 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. on July 29-30-31, 2017.

The subject of the paintings is to be the 150-year-old brick girlhood home, possibly to include the nearby prairie.

Workshop participants will be responsible for providing their own materials: watercolors, 11x14 (40 lb.) watercolor paper, palette, and brushes.

The National 19th Amendment Society will have the finished watercolor paintings matted for display at its annual open house on August 19.

In addition, the paintings will be included in a later show at the Charles City Art Center.

Participants are expected to attend all days of the workshop. Ownership of the completed paintings will be retained by the artists with the agreement to loan them to the National 19th Amendment Society for above mentioned events.
